
"Stromberg-Carlson" A.C. Broadcast Model 574



This receiver is a five-valve broadcast, A.C. operated, console which was produced during 1934, and is fitted with an 8-inch, 1,000 ohms field, loudspeaker. Particular attention should be paid to the cathode wiring of the 6F7, I.F. and A.F. amplifier, and the 76, diode detector, as the arrangement provides an initial bias of 2 volts for the audio (triode) section of the 6F7.
