VACUUM ANTENNAE

SUBJECT - LUBRICATION.

Do not use any other oil than Neatsfoot or Castor Oil for lubricating the gland nut packing or main Cylinder plunger. Ordinary machine or engine oil will rot and destroy the leather washers.

This antenna works from the vacuum of manifold, and as the suction tends to draw out the lubrications, it should be lubricated whenever it shows signs of sticking or moving slowly.

The antenna when in a raised position, naturally collects dirt on its surface, due to the film of oil applied as it passes through the gland nut. Every time it is lowered, this dirt is wiped off on to the gland nut packing, and should be cleaned off periodically.

For best operation, it is necessary that all parts work freely and without binding.
