The cassettes with and without tapes for dictation machines EL 3582 and EL 3583 have been changed.

The type numbers of the new cassettes are:

Cassette with tape	EL 3779/01N
Cassette without tape	EL 3779/51N

The blocking lever of the old cassette (codenumber 4822 215 00879) can still be supplied as long as the stock lasts.

As with the new cassette both halves are glued together and the blocking lever can no longer be replaced, it is no longer supplied for the new cassette.

Both tape ends (red and green) and the feed strip have also been changed.

Spring	4822 214 00444

The new tape ends are supplied with the feed strip welded to them. The code numbers are:

Tape end (red)	4822 215 00908
Tape end (green)	4822 215 00909

Ear bracket EL 3957 has been replaced by ear bracket 4822 097 00741.

A test tape in cassette is available for adjusting the recording/playback head of the EL 3582 and EL 3583 dictation machines. It is necessary to use this test tape in order to obtain a proper adjustment of these heads. The code number of the tape is:

Test tape in cassette	4822 215 00863
-----------------------	----------------

The head should be adjusted by means of a special screwdriver which can also be used for replacing springs located at poorly accessible positions inside the apparatus.

The screwdriver consists of the following parts:

Screwdriver	A9 600 54
Grip	A9 600 55
