MODELS 1924-1926 - Fit receiver to dash below petrol tank.

MODELS 1927-1928 - In narrow track models receiver must be mounted on special bracket, Part No. A1021.

MODELS 1929-1933 - Same as above except Morris Minor; Glove Box must be cut away in this model.

MODEL 1934. - Morris Cowley Six:

Mount set on floor immediately in front of gear lever, making sure that gear lever is in its most forward position when clearing tone control knob.

Morris Isis: Normal mounting.

NOTE: The early models have a magneto. 50,000 ohm Suppressor should be used.

From 1929 onwards, the automobiles use battery
