AUTO RADIO SERVICE BULLETIN.

SUBJECT - INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR 1938 10/4  
VAUXHALL CARS.

The radio receiver for this car is 6 volt and mounts at left hand side on angle of dash using packing blocks supplied in the control package. These packing blocks are required to see that the receiver lays above wire harness cable.

The Acoustinator fits at left hand of Instrument panel under the glove box.

When fitting the control it may be necessary to cut away some edges left on glove box trimming which might protrude at rear of panel thereby showing at edge of dial window.

It is necessary to insert the control cables into the receiver before bolting receiver into position because of the restricted space for the receiver.

Over car antenna only can be installed there being no running board on car. The angle of the leadin rod where it enters cowl must be bent to conform with increased angle of cowl so that it lays parallel to windscreen as in the last paragraph in instructions for installing overcar antenna.

The speaker is the 6" flush headerboard type Part No. M10,030, the lead of which comes down the Left hand wind shield post.
